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Notice of Student Admission into 1st Year BDS Class of Dhaka Dental College

1. Applications on prescribed forms are invited for admission into 1st Year B.D.S. class of academic session 1986-87.
2. Candidates must have passed S.S.C. examination from any group, H.S.C. examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or equivalent examination approved by Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, obtaining 60 per cent marks in both the examinations, i.e. 1200 marks out of total 2000 (excluding grace marks, additional marks and marks for irregular). Anyone who passed any of the SSC and HSC examination in Third Division will not be eligible to apply.
3. 1 (one) seat will be kept reserved for tribal candidates, and they must have passed both the SSC and HSC examinations at least in 2nd Division.
4. Only the students who have passed HSC examination in 1986 and SSC in 1984 will be considered as regular candidate. Those who have passed SSC before 1984, 25 marks will be deducted from their total marks of HSC examination for each year of irregularity. Participants in the improvement examination will be considered as irregular candidates and in this case 10 marks will be deducted.
5. Students will be admitted on the basis of marks obtained in the written examination of 100 marks and no Viva Voce will be held.
6. In case of irregular candidates 2.5 marks will be deducted for each year of irregularity from the marks obtained in the written examination.
7. Admission Form can be collected from the office of Dental College on submission of Registration Fee Tk. 10 (ten) and Admission Test Fee Tk. 80 (eighty) totaling Tk. 90 (ninety). Admission Form may be collected on payment of cash Tk. 10 (ten) only but in this case Tk. 80 (eighty) should be paid in cash as Admission Test fee at the time of submitting admission form. No admission form will be sent through post.
8. Other information regarding admission may be known from Dental College office.
9. Final decision as to the eligibility of admission will be taken after medical test by the Medical Board.
10. Candidates have to submit at the time of admission all certificates and original copies of other certificates. Otherwise they will be considered unfit for admission.
11. Duly filled in prescribed admission form should be submitted with Dhaka Dental College Office. Along with applications, following copies of certificates must be given :-

- (a) Attested photostat copy of SSC certificate.
 - (b) Attested photostat copy of certificate regarding passing of HSC examination obtained from the Principal of the College from where candidate appeared at the examination.
 - (c) Attested copies of mark sheets of HSC and SSC examinations.
 - (d) Attested copy of testimonial regarding character of the candidate from the last attended educational institution.
 - (e) Character certificate of candidate from a first class gazetted officer.
 - (f) Attested copy of nationality certificate.
 - (g) Attested copy of certificate about annual income of father/guardian and district of inhabitation from a first class gazetted officer or Union Council Chairman.
 - (h) Original copy of certificate given by the Deputy Commissioner regarding permanent district of inhabitation in case of students of Chittagong Hill Tracts, Khagrachari and Bandarban districts.
 - (i) 3 (three) recent attested passport-size photographs.
 - (j) Receipt of Tk. 90- (ninety) paid as registration and admission fees.
11. No application will be accepted after the last date and time of receiving applications. Incomplete applications will be considered as rejected.
 12. All information about admission will be available in the notice board of Dhaka Dental College. No communication will be made in this regard with the candidates.
 13. Since there is shortage of seats at Dental College, students have to make their own arrangement of boarding.
 14. Last date of receiving applications is 31.3.1987 till 1 p.m.
 15. Date and venue of written examination will be available later in the notice board of Dental College.
