1. Graduate Diplomas and/or Master's Degrees in Development Economics	02 (two)	M.A. in Economics. Minimum two 1st classes / divisions and no 3rd class/division at any level in educational career.
2. Graduate Diplomas and/or Master's Degree in Forestry	02 (two)	M.Ag./B.Ag. Minimum Two First classes / divisions out of which one in B.Ag. or M.Ag.
3. Master's of Medical Science in Community Health Programme	01 (one)	Regular MBBS with 1st Division both in SSC and HSC Examinations having preferably a Diploma in Community Health Programme.
4. Master's Degree in Health Administration	01 (one)	Regular MBBS with 1st Division both in SSC & HSC Examinations having in service training in Health Administration.
5. Graduate Diploma and/or Master's Degree in Community Nutrition	01 (one)	Regular MBBS with 1st Division both in SSC & HSC Examinations having in service training in Community Nutrition.
6. Graduate Diplomas in Public Administration	02 (two)	M.A with two first classes/divisions and no 3rd class/division at any level in educational career with four years experience in administrative management.
7. Graduate Diploma and/or Master's Degree in Agricultural Studies	01 (one)	M.Ag./B.Ag. Minimum two 1st classes/divisions out of which one in B.Ag. or M.Ag.
8. Master's Degree in Chemistry Research Techniques	01 (one)	Master's degree in Chemistry. Minimum two first classes/divisions having Research background and no 3rd division at any level in educational career.
