



Invitation of Application for Admission into Dip-in-Ed and M.Ed (Day and Part-time Evening) Programmes.

Applications are invited from the citizens of Bangladesh for admission into (a) Dip-in-Ed and (b) M.Ed. (day and Part-time evening) Programmes. Application must reach the Office of the Institute by 2:00 pm, Tuesday, May 23, 1989.

Applicants for Dip-in-Ed. programme must have a Bachelor's degree with at least two second divisions/classes from SSC/Matriculation to Bachelor's/Master's (if any) degree.

Applicants for M.Ed. (regular and part-time evening) programme must have Dip-in-Ed/B. Ed and have at least two second Classes/Divisions from SSC/Matriculation to Dip-in-Ed/B. Ed. Those who appeared at the B.Ed/Dip-in-Ed. Examination in 1989 can also apply, if they fulfil other requirements.

Requirement of one second division/class in examinations for admission in any of the above programmes may be relaxed in the case of candidates having teaching experience for a long period after Bachelor's/Master's degree.

A number of stipends are available for Dip-in-Ed. students at the rate of Tk 200/- monthly and M.Ed (regular) students at the rate of Tk 250/- monthly. Stipends cannot be claimed as a matter of right. No stipend is available for part-time evening M.Ed. students. During study in Dip-in-Ed. and M. Ed (regular) Programmes no student shall be a student or an examinee of any other educational programme or an employee of any organisation, other than those who shall be on leave or on deputation.

Applicants for admission into Dip-in-Ed. and M. Ed (regular and part-time evening) programmes will have to submit applications on plain paper with the following particulars: name, father's name, permanent address, present address, date of birth, examinations passed with divisions/classes and year, teaching experience and programme for which admission is sought. Applicants must submit one passport size photograph, cash Tk 40/- or bank draft of Tk 40/- in favour of Director, IER and original copies of certificates of teaching experience and attested copies of Original/Provisional certificates of all examinations previously passed. No testimonial and marksheet will be accepted in lieu of certificates. Those who passed Bachelor's (Hons) degree examination held in 1985 or later will have to submit a testimonial from the Chairman of their respective department to the effect that at present the applicant is neither a student of that department nor an examinee. Those who are in service must apply through proper channel. Experience in non-govt. school must be supported by the index number of govt. benefits received otherwise experience will not be counted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Admission Tests:

The list of eligible candidates for appearing at the admission tests will be displayed on the Institute Notice Board on June 5, 1989 by 2:00 pm. No letter will be sent in this regard to the applicants. No T.A. and D.A. will be paid for appearing at the admission tests.

Written admission test for Dip-in-Ed. programme will be held on Saturday, June 10, 1989 at 9 am in the Institute and oral examination on the following day, June 11 from 9 am.

Written admission test for M.Ed (regular and part time evening) will be held on Sunday June 12, 1989 at 9 am and Oral examination on the same day from 2-30 pm.

The lists of eligible candidates for admission will be hung up on the Notice Board in the afternoon on Sunday June 25, 1989. The eligible candidates of Dip-in-Ed Programme will have to get themselves admitted on Saturday the 1st July 1989 and M.Ed (regular and part-time evening) on Sunday the 2nd July, 1989 between 9 am to 4 pm on submission of necessary documents and fees. Classes will begin from 3rd July, 1989.
