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Education in coaching centres

Nowadays Dhaka city is filled with many coaching centres where no good system prevails to coach the students. But the authorities of these centres take good sums of money from the respective guardians but do not teach their children accordingly. It is really harmful to our nation.

All the coaching centres of Dhaka city bear same characteristics which are as follows:

(i) The authorities take good sums of money but the students are hardly offered good teaching.

(ii) Sometimes the authorities test the students to maintain the formalities only but when they see that the student can not cut good figure in the examination, they give more marks to satisfy their guardians and also the students.

(iii) Here the students are taught not by particular teacher and you may find that English is taught by Mathematics teacher, Bengali is taught by Arabic teacher, History is taught by Geography teacher etc. On the whole, no proper system of teaching exists there. So our young students are be-

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ing deprived of good education.

I earnestly request the guardians not to send their children to such centres. They (guardians) should remember these are not coaching centres, rather they are traps for earning money. So these centres should be named 'Money Earning Centres.' The organisers of such centres only want money but they never want to give the students any proper education. What they do is only to maintain formalities.

I also appeal to the Education Ministry to keep strict watch on these coaching centres. If this system continues the backbone of our education may be broken down within a short span of time.

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
