Education system must meet need of the hour

CHITTAGONG, May 20: The two-day seminar on "maximum utilisation of internal resources" ended here on Thursday adopting a number of recommendations including formulation of national uplift policy, based on country's own resources, experts and technology, reports BSS.

The seminar, organised by Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCC and I), was inaugurated by Prime Minister Moudud Ahmed.

More than 50 eminent experts and academicians from all over the country took part in seven sessions during the two-day deliberations and over two dozen papers on various fields of national economic activities were presented in the seminar.

Stressing the need for tapping both human and natural resources, the seminar observed that for the proper utilisation of country's huge manpower the education system must be recast, matching with the need of the hour.

The seminar identified poultry farming and dairy farming to boost country's national economy.

It recommended acquisition of high breeding varieties of livestock, technically skilled manpower, adequate production of inputs and proper policy decision and its correct implementations to gear up this vital sector.

The seminar critically discussed the present trend of utilising loans taken by various entrepreneurs from different loan giving institutions including nationalised commercial banks and opined that the loan realisation position is not satisfactory at all.
