Scope of admission in universities

We are disturbed to learn that thirty five thousand applications have been submitted for admission in to the 1st year Honours Class of different faculties in Dhaka University. Similarly twenty seven thousand have applied for admission into Jahangir Nagar University. The Dhaka University will take three thousand while Jahangir Nagar University will admit only five hundred in 1st year Honours Classes.

In some cases the students

have applied to more than one unit to get themselves admitted in any subject. When we are talking about providing education to all, we are at the same time denying higher education to the potential students. Most of the students seeking admission got first divisions both in H.S.C and S.S.C or one first division in either of the stages. But more than fifty eight thousands of them will not get any admission in these universities.

The university authorities are opening the door of despondency to the students and their parents right from this stage. The despondency of the students and parents reaches the climax when they find session jam after getting admission into the classes. What is the fault of these innocent students? They have tried to make good result in both H.S.C/S.S.C as expected from them by their parents, well wishers and the nation.

But despite achieving good

results, the door of their higher education is shut. Jahangir Nagar University has got enough scope to provide higher education facilities to a good number of students, but it has not been explored thread-bare. Will the authorities concerned chalk out some liberal programme before the admission test so as to admit more students?
