

55.26 pc pass Dacca Board SSC exam

The results of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) under Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Dacca were announced on Saturday, the percentage of pass being 55.26.

Khaled Sobhan of Saint Joseph High School bearing roll number Dacca 49569 topped the combined merit list. He secured 842 marks with six letters. Samira Abbasi bearing roll number F46055 of Vikarunnessa No. 1 School and Shamsuddin Ahmed Chowdhury (roll: 61531) secured second and third position respectively in the combined merit list. Samira secured 828 marks and Shamsuddin secured 820 marks. They also got letter in six subjects.

A total number of 62,999 candidates in all six groups appeared at the examinations this year of whom 34,812 candidates came out successful. Among the successful candidates, 4,514 were placed in the First Division, 13,657 in the Second Division and 16,641 in the third division.

In Humanities Group, 32,302 candidates appeared for the examinations of whom 13,318 came out successful. Among the successful candidates, 124 secured first division, 3,487

Second Division and 9,705 Third Division. The percentage of pass was 41.23.

In the Science Group, 15,170 students came out successful out of the total number of 19,622 candidates appeared. Of the successful candidates, 4,061 got First Division, 7,139 Second Division and 3,870 Third Division. The percentage of pass being 76.80.

In the Commerce Group, 6,287 candidates appeared of whom 3,397 came out successful. Among the successful candidates, 132 secured first division, 1,479 second Division and 1,786 Third Division.

In Agriculture Group, 3,969 candidates appeared of whom 2,498 were successful. Among the successful candidates, 107 secured First Division, 1,297 Second Division and 1,094 Third Division. The percentage of pass was 62.94.

In Home Economics Group, 623 candidates appeared of whom 353 were successful. Of them, nine secured First Division, 182 Second Division and 162 Third Division. The percentage of pass was 56.66.

In Industrial Arts Group, 199 candidates appeared of whom 176 were successful. Of them 79 secured first Division, 73 Second Division and 24 Third Division. The percentage of pass was 88.90.

Samira Abbasi, the elder of two daughters of folk singer Mr. Mostafa Zaman Abbasi and Mrs. Asma Abbasi, who has secured the second position in the Combined Merit list of the SSC examinations of Dacca Education Board this year wants to be an architect.

She said that the profession of an architect appeared very attractive to her because it was essentially creative in nature. She had appeared from Vikarunnessa Noon School.

A brilliant student although, Samira Abbasi has got second grade primary scholarship in 1974 and stood first among the first grade junior scholarship recipients of 1977 in Dacca Division.

Samira Abbasi is a young Radio and Television artist and takes active interest in debate, recitation and painting. Asked what did one need for achieving good results at examinations, she said one should take interest in studies and be regular about it. One should also read books beyond the syllabi and should aim at having a better grasp of language and literature.

Samira Abbasi said she used to read for five hours a day regularly. She was taught by a private tutor after her test examination at the school.

Asked why she did not like to become a professional singer, in keeping with her family tradition, she said she liked to continue singing as a matter of hobby, not as a profession.

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Khaled had secured the third position in first grade junior scholarship of 1977 in Dacca Division.

He regularly takes part in the educational programme of Radio Bangladesh. Khaled is also a good sportsman and plays football, volleyball, cricket. He was the captain of his school football team. He also secured prizes in different debate competitions and science exhibitions.

Khaled used to read for 12 hours a day. But he never read in the afternoon, the time he used to spend by taking part in sports and games. Khaled was taught by four house tutors after the test examination at his school.

According to Khaled one should be regular and attentive to his studies to do good results in examinations. One should complete the days work on time by following a routine. One should also read books beyond the syllabi, he said.

Khaled Sobhan said he was hopeful that he would be among the first ten candidates in the combined merit list of the SSC examinations but never thought that he would be able to occupy the top position.
