

SSC exams begin

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations of 1978 began all over the country on Thursday. Only one candidate from Jessore Board was expelled on the opening day.

The controllers of examinations from different education boards told the Times that the examinations were held in a peaceful atmosphere and no untoward incident was heard.

They said that students showed less inclinations towards adoption of unfair means in the examination halls.

The Controller of Jessore Board said that only one candidate was expelled from Khajura Centre (10 miles away from Jessore town) under the board on the opening day.

BSS from Chittagong says: About 52,000 students have been appearing at the examination under the Comilla Board.

In Chittagong 1,804 students from different schools are appearing at 6 sub-centres.

Meanwhile, the district administration has promulgated 144 Cr. P.C. around the examination centres to ensure a congenial atmosphere for the examinees.

The examination was held peacefully in all centres here.
