

Student roll increases in primary schools of Chuadanga

CHUADANGA, June 17: A total of 1,55,783 students are now going to primary schools in all the four thanas of Chuadanga district, reports BSS.

According to an official source, of the total primary students, 7,273 are taking lesson in infant class, 40,842 in class I (one), 29,241 in class II (two), 31,464 in class III (three), 75 in class IV (four) and 20,788 in class V (five).

The thana wise primary students are: Chuadanga Sadar-38,611, Alamdanga-48,171, Damurhuda-41,893 and Jibannagar-26,562. The total number of primary schools in

the district is 930. It is learnt that a total of 1,58,000 students got themselves admitted in the primary schools of the district during the current academic session of which about 2000 students have left the schools.

BORO HARVEST

Another BSS report: The harvesting of Boro paddy of the current season completed in all the four thanas of Chuadanga district, reports BSS.

The four thanas of the district are Chuadanga sadar, Alamdanga, Damurhuda and Jibannagar.

According to an official source, during the current season a total of 1,14,000 tonnes of

Boro paddy have been produced in the district of which 22,000 tonnes have been produced in Chuadanga sadar thana, 30,000 tonnes in Damurhuda thana and 28,000 tonnes in Jibannagar thana. During this season a total of 21,700 hectares were brought under Boro cultivation in the district.

POURA SCHEMES

BSS further reports: Chuadanga pourashava will implement 33 schemes in the current financial year at an allocation of Taka 1,09,90,000.

The schemes include construction and reconstruction of roads, construction of public latrines and urinals and slaughtering houses.
