Varsity at Barisal soon: Biswas

President Abdur Rahman Biswas said in Dhaka on Thursday that all-out efforts were to be made for further development of the socio-economic condition of the country, reports BSS.

The people in general, their elected representatives and the government machinery must work unitedly for the betterment of the people, he added, reports BSS.

President Biswas was talking to a delegation of Chairmen and members of the Union Parishads of Barisal Sadar, when they called on him at Bangabhaban on Thursday. It was led by Mohammed Shahjahan Bhuiyan, Chairman of Charkawa Union Parishad.

President Biswas said that we must remove the curse of illiteracy from the country adding that without enhancing the rate of literacy no nation can prosper. In this connection, he laid stress on checking drop-outs at the primary level education, which has been made compulsory. There is no difference between a girl and a boy today if they could be properly educated and trained up for undertaking future responsibilities, he added.

Referring to their demand for early implementation of Sikarpur-Duarika bridge project, President Biswas said that since it was a commitment of the government, Inshallah it will be materialised as early as possible. establishment of a full-fledged University at Barisal will also be materialised in course of time, he added.
