Non-govt primary teachers benefit money increases

The government has decided to increase the teachers' benefit for registered non-government primary schools and pay the money through banks, an official announcement said in Dhaka on Monday, reports BSS.

Earlier, Thana Education Officers used to disburse the money among the teachers after drawing it from Thana Accounts Office.

Under the new system, all teachers will open their accounts in their personal names with the thana headquarters branch of the concerned banks and will draw their money through cheques.

The division-wise prescribed banks include Agrani Bank for Dhaka division, Sonali Bank for Rajshahi division, Rupali bank for Khulna and Barisal divisions and Janata Bank for Chittagong division.

The authorities further decided that the teachers will open their accounts in their bank where the prescribed banks for them are not in existence.

Meanwhile, the government had already taken necessary measures to send the benefit-money upto thana level through concerned banks. Those teachers having no account, have been asked to open accounts immediately for the convenience of drawing their money.
