

9 new pry school bldgs in Faridpur Help expand education in rural areas : Yusuf

FARIDPUR, Nov 2: Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf inaugurated newly constructed nine primary school buildings at sadar thana in Faridpur district Monday, reports BSS.

The total cost of constructions of the buildings is about taka 50 lakh of these government primary school buildings are Tambulkhana, Mangal Kot, Ranokail, Ramkhand, Puradia, Raikali, Kusha Gopalpur, Akan Vatpara and Kachnail Yusuf Ali non-government primary school.

Addressing a public gathering at the newly constructed Raikali Primary School premises, the Health Minister said, the social elite, local leaders and NGOs could play effective role side by side with the government in expansion of education in rural areas of the country. He said, the present government has attached highest priority to the education sector and the dropouts of school going students has reduced tremendously.

Chowdhury Kamal stressed the need for monitoring and evaluation of the performance of the teachers and students of all government and non-government educational institutions of the country.

Later, the Health Minister also laid foundation stone of Gopaldi Bazar Union Health and Family Welfare Centre (FWC) under Modhukhali thana. The government has allocated about 20 lakh for the construction of the F.W.C after the completion of the union sub-centre's, about 12 thousand people will be directly benefited in different ways in health care from this centre.
