Amoda Govt Pry School smarting under problems

NARAIL Dec 23: The Amoda Government Primary School under Lohagora thana is beset with various problems hampering education of the children.

According to school sources about 300 students of the school have been facing problems due to shortage of class rooms, benches and other educational appliance. As a result most of them are compelled to have their classes in the open.

Besides, shortage of teachers has also been hampering the education of the children. It is alleged that most of the teachers come to the school only once or twice a week and that too just to sign attendance registers.

Moreover, there is no arrangement for the supply of pure water in the school.

The guardians have urged the concerned authorities to look into the matter and take immediate measures to redress the suffering of the students.

POLYTHENE BAGS
