2 pty schools to be rebuilt in M'bazar

MAULVIBAZAR, Sept 12: At least two Primary schools will be reconstructed in Maulvibazar and Srimangal pourashava of the district during the current fiscal year.

Facilities Department sources said an amount of Tk. 32 lakh has been sanctioned by the government for the reconstruction of Sreenath Government Primary School under Maulvibazar Pourashava and Jagendra Pathshala under Srimangal pourashava.

After re-construction of these schools primary education of the pourashava areas will be improved greatly. Besides, Govinda Sree Government Primary School, Bazar Government Primary School and Pourashava Adarsha Uchcha Bidyalaya of the town will be repaired with a cost of Tk. 1,80,000.

Moreover, an amount of Tk. 10,60,000 has been also sanctioned for the boundary wall, sanitation, electrification, water supply and gas connection of the Moulvibazar Primary Teachers Training Institute.
