

Armed group creates terror in Eden College

The convener of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal Mr. Amanullah Aman in a Press statement on Thursday expressed his deep concern and regret over the unhappy incident inside the campus of the Eden Government Girls College on Thursday.

He said that a group of armed hoodlums entered the campus of the College and created a reign of terror by brandishing fire arms which caused panic among the girl students.

Mr. Aman who is also the Vice-President of DUCSU remarked that at a time when the people were eagerly waiting a free and fair elections in the country, an unidentified

quarter was engaged in the acts of terrorism all over the country. He demanded immediate arrest of those armed hoodlums and called upon the people to create resistance against them.

The General Students Council of Government Eden Girls College condemned the attack on the students by a gang of armed persons.

The members of the students council of the College said that when the students of the college were engaged in the movement for the removal of the principal of the college for a long time, a group of hired armed persons belonging to a student organisation suddenly attacked and chased the students with fire arms.

The Vice President and General Secretary of Rokeya Hall Students Union Shirin Sultana and Sahena Akhter Sacu in a press statement on Thursday expressed their concern over the attack on the Students inside the campus of Eden Girls College by an armed hoodlums.

The V.P. demanded immediate removal of the principal, a close associate of the ousted president and arrest of those armed miscreants who were responsible for this heinous acts on the campus.
