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New Zealand Government scholarship

I went to New Zealand for higher studies as per Government order of deputation vide Memo No. ME-(F-T) 486-671 dated 06-12-86. I submitted my joining report to service in Bangladesh on 27th October 1987 after returning from New Zealand. My joining report could not be accepted by the authorities concerned

because the Director General of Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute, Joydevpur, Gazipur had not received any information about me till the 29th December 1987. It is a long time that I am staying in Bangladesh without having my joining report accepted.

I was granted 73 days earned leave and 42 days leave without pay by the Director General, Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute for coming to Dhaka to move file from office to office like a peon

in connection with my foreign training in New Zealand and performing official works etc. prior to my departure from Bangladesh. I am now again being verbally asked to move file from office to office.

I request the Government to convey some message or decision of the authority to Director General, Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute regarding my joining service in Bangladesh or foreign training in New Zealand. It may be mentioned here that I have duly submitted my report on return to Bangladesh in prescribed form. Formal application addressed to Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Government of Bangladesh was also posted on 9th December, 1987. The decision of Bangladesh authority regarding my future should be finalised immediately in the greater interest of public service.

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
