

Students' concern over govt college teachers' strike

The students of different government colleges in Dacca city at a meeting at the Teachers' Training College premises on Wednesday discussed their problems arising out of the long strike by the government college teachers.

They also formed an 18-member "Dacca City Student's Action Council."

The students at the meeting expressed their concern over the deadlock created in the government colleges and urged the government to immediately fulfil the demands of the government college teachers with a view to restoring congenial atmosphere in those institutions.

They said that the students would fast into death and take other programmes had the teachers been forced to go on hunger strike and "Dacca March" programme to press their demand.

The students at the meeting also demanded shifting of the Higher Secondary Certificate and other examinations by at least two months and exemption of tuition fees for the period covered by the teachers' strike, said a press release signed by Messrs Mohan Raihan and Quamrul Ahsan on Friday.

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
