

300 new books to appear at Book Fair

About three hundred new books will appear on the occasion of Ekushe February Book Fair '96, reports Media Syndicate.

The theme of this year's Ekushe February Book Fair is to extend the horizon of knowledge by reading more books and motivating the people to read. Bangla Academy has been publishing, on an average, hundred books on arts, literature, science, medicine and religion on a regular basis annually. The Academy has published four thousand books on various subjects during forty years since its inception.

Mansur Musa, Director General, Bangla Academy said that the Academy had been successful to publish books on different subjects since inception despite financial constraints. He
