Teachers urged to take profession as mission

Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar Wednesday laid emphasis on establishment of moral values through education system for establishing an ideal society says BSS.

The Education Minister was speaking as chief guest at a seminar on education organised by Bangladesh Ideal Teacher's Council at National Press Club in Dhaka Wednesday.

Presided over by President of the Council Dr. Mohammad Lokman, the seminar was addressed by Vice Chancellor of the Bangladesh Open University Dr. M. Shamser Ali.

Mr Nurul Islam read out the keynote written by Dr Syed Sajjad Hossain in the seminar.

Among others, Principal Ataur Rahman and Dr. Anisuzzaman took part in the discussion.

The Education Minister said the teachers must take teaching not merely as a profession but as a mission and they must devote themselves for building the country.

Mr. Sircar said high moral values and rationality of life must be

reflected in the education system. He also stressed on the need for inclusion of moral values, patriotism and religious values in the curriculum for making the good citizens of the country.
