

Highest amount allocated in edn sector: Anwar

SANARPAR, (Narayanganj), Feb 5: Commerce Minister M.K. Anwar said here Thursday that the government had allocated the highest amount in education sector in the budget of the current fiscal year for the uplift of our population, reports BSS.
