



## Non-govt teachers to get arrears in savings bond

Central leaders of the Federation of Teachers' Associations of Bangladesh led by Religious Affairs Minister and Secretary General of the Organisation, Maulana M. A. Mannan met President H. M. Ershad at President's Secretariat in Dhaka on Tuesday evening, reports BSS.

The Federation leaders had a free and frank exchange of views on the problems of the teachers and of education sector with the President who is also the Chairman of the Organisation.

The President announced that the arrears accumulated following enhancement of the salary support from 60 per cent to 70 per cent by the Government to the teachers of non-government educational institutions at secondary and higher secondary levels will

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be paid in National Savings Bond for six months from July to December 1986.

He said the enhanced amount will be paid from January this year with the monthly payments to the non-government teachers.

Meanwhile, the Ministry of Education as per the decision of the President had taken steps for payment of the enhanced amount and the matter is now lying with the Ministry of Finance for implementation.

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
