Mahbub visits Dhaka, Jaydevpur exam centres

Education Minister Mahbubur Rahman on Saturday visited different SSC examination centres in Dhaka and Jaydevpur, reports BSS.

During his visit the Minister was apprised that the examinations in all the centres were being held peacefully and smoothly.

The Minister visited the centres at Westend High School, Agrani Girls, High School and Government Laboratory High School in Dhaka and Rani Bilashmoni Government High School and Jaydevpur Girls

SSC exams begin: 139 expelled

Secondary School Certificate (S.S.C.) examinations under four education boards in the country began peacefully on Saturday.

A total of 3,66,513 candidates are appearing in the examination from 590 centres this year.

A total 1,13,260 candidates including 36,529 girls are appearing from Dhaka Board.

On the first day of the examination a total of 139 cases of expulsion were reported while four outsiders were arrested.

In Dhaka city no case of unfair means was detected in any

of the 41 centres, according to Board authorities.

In Comilla, two were expelled from Gangamandal and one from Feni on the first day.

Our correspondent from Rajshahi informed that examination was held peacefully on the first day.

A total of 87,573 candidates including 23,970 girls appeared from 153 centres under Rajshahi Board this year.

In Birganj Upazila under Thakurgaon district, a total of 37 candidates were expelled on the first day. In Rubia and Ranisanka under the district, the

number of expulsion were two and one respectively.

Similarly in Chapainawabganj, the number was two and in Natore and Bogra town it was one each.

Our Jessore Correspondent reports: SSC examination was started peacefully on Saturday. A total of 79,775 candidates including 24,278 females appeared in the examinations.

Only four candidates have been expelled for adopting unfair means on the first day.

RANGPUR

Our Rangpur Correspondent adds: Three outsiders were arrested by police and 81 candidates including two girls were expelled on the first day.

According to official source 74 candidates have been expelled from Ulipur upazila centre.

GAZIPUR

According to Gazipur Correspondent, police on Saturday arrested one Dalal Chandra Mandal for supplying forged admit card to an SSC examinee from Nilerpara High School under Gazipur Sadar upazila.

The forged admit card was detected when the centre superintendent of Rani Bilashmoni High School challenged one Barkatullah whose name was not found in examinees list. The boy, however, disclosed that he obtained the admit card from one howe Chandra Mandal on a payment of Tk 1,700. Police was informed and Dalal was arrested on 1st day. Three candidates were expelled from Gazipur.
