

## New education policy to reflect people's values

TANGAIL, Oct. 2: Kazi Zafar Ahmed, Minister for Education, has said that the country's education policy would reflect the human, social, economic and democratic values of the people as well as their patriotism and religious sentiments, reports ESS.

Addressing a cross section of people in the chamber of the Deputy Commissioner last night, the Education Minister pointed out that the education policy to be framed after free and frank discussions at all levels would be people and production oriented and consistent with the needs of time. Nothing would be imposed on the people, he said.

He said that the second national workshop on education would be held soon for free and frank discussions on education policy. Besides, education camps would be held at the divisional, district and sub-divisional levels all over the country to facilitate discussions on it. Mr Ahmed told the distinguished gathering that all-out measures were underway to improve the education and the lot of the teachers. A society cannot be called a developed one in which education and educationists are not honoured, he observed.
