

SSC exams begin tomorrow

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations of 1981 under the four education boards will begin all over the country tomorrow (Thursday).

The education boards have already completed necessary preparations for holding the examinations.

Meanwhile the district administration of Dacca has taken a number of steps for ensuring smooth and peaceful conduct of the examinations in the district. A meeting in this regard was held at the Dacca Collectorate on Monday.

Presided over by Mr A H Mofazzal Karim Deputy Commissioner of Dacca; the meeting resolved that the Public Examination (Offences) Ordinance, 1980 would be strictly followed.

The Dacca city has been divided into five zones with 33 centres and sub-centres for the purpose.
