Budget allocation for edn to be increased

PANCHAGARI, Mar 11: Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar today said the BNP government was implementing numerous epoch-making programmes with a view to eradicating the curse of illiteracy from the country, reports BSS.

He was addressing separate functions while laying foundation stones of academic buildings of Atowary Pilot High School, Balarampur High School and Science Building of Sardarpara High School under Atowary thana.
