

Majid for modern education system

MAGURA, Apr 11: Agriculture and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister Maj Gen (Retd) M Majid-Ul-Haq emphasised the need for modern education system and high quality teachers community to build dutiful students who will be able to fulfil the nation's requirement, reports UNB.

The Minister was addressing as chief guest in separate inaugural functions of four newly constructed buildings of four primary schools of the district on Sunday, an official handout said.

Majid-Ul-Haq while detailing the education policy of the present government said highest allocation has been given in education sector with a view to remove illiteracy from the country.
