Prime Minister Begum  
Khaleida Zia on Thursday called  
for building a well co-ordinated  
social mobilisation in "education  
for all" and launching it as a  
community programme, reports  
BSS.

"Education must be launched  
as a community programme.  
Along with other development ac-  
tivities this programme has to be  
integrated at the grassroots level,"  
she said while inaugurating the  
national conference on "education  
for all—social mobilisation" at the  
Shilpakala Academy auditorium  
here.

The Prime Minister urged all  
conscious social organisations and  
forces to come forward to imple-

gramme as it was an imperative  
for the country's overall develop-

She said a democratic govern-  
ment must be in power. The most  
important factor in democracy is

The Minister said "to
