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Re-introduction of Primary Central Exam proposed

The Primary Central Examination of students who have completed the primary education level, should be re-introduced to ensure a better participation of students, teachers and guardians in the educational field.

This was proposed by the Bangladesh Primary Teachers Association on Friday.

The President of the Association Mr Abul Kalam Azad while talking to newsmen at Jatiya Press Club stressed that every primary school should have at least ten to fifteen students in class five and every student should appear at this examination. If in any school more than 50 per cent of the students fail for three consecutive years, the teachers should be removed he added. It was also proposed that the question papers should be set by the representatives of District Teachers Association government representatives and other educationists.

Provident fund, pension group insurance, welfare fund etc. of the primary teachers should also be started, he added. A Committee should be set up with members of the local government, local influential persons and teachers of the institution to mobilise both guardians and students to make primary education a success, he added.
