Govt college teachers suspend abstention plan

Bangladesh Government College Professor's Association and Lecturers Association have suspended their programme of abstaining from work scheduled from May 7 following a fruitful discussion with Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar on Thursday in view of the SSC examination now being held throughout the country, an official handout said, reports BSS.

The 12-point demands of the associations including creation of new posts in 233 government colleges, giving higher scale for the assistant and associate professors and professors, promotion of teachers to the vacant posts within May 31 and retrospective effect for promoted and affected teachers.
