

Govt urged to withdraw all amendments to DU Order '73

A general meeting of the Dacca University Teachers' Association was held on Wednesday.

The meeting in a resolution urged the Government to immediately withdraw all amendments to the Dacca University Order, 1973.

The meeting urged the deans of different faculties of the university who have taken charges as deans under the provisions of the amendments to resign immediately and called upon the teachers not to participate in election of deans under provisions of the amendments.

In another resolution the meeting decided that the teachers would not cooperate with those who would take charges as chairmen of departments, according to the procedures provided under the amendments.

The meeting demanded higher rate of house rent to teachers and provision for free medical treatment of the members of their families.
