Education of girl students hampered at Kishoreganj

KISHOREGANJ, May 10 : Students of Kishoreganj Girls' High School are finding it hard to continue their studies for want of hostel accommodation.

The number of girls student is increasing every year but hostel accommodation for them is not expanding proportionately.

In addition, the students of the school are experiencing handicapped for want of a play ground. In the absence of a playground the students are not getting proper scope for participating in outdoor games. An open space in the school compound is too small to serve the purpose.
