

DUCSU polls drive at peak

With the much awaited DUCSU polls drawing nearer campaign by different student groups and organisations reached its peak on Saturday.

The students wing of BNP, Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatradal (JCD), brought out a procession on the day seeking votes for its 'Aman-Khokon' panel. Hundreds of jubilant JCD activists paraded the campus chanting slogans in favour of 'Aman-Khokon' panel.

Kabir Khokon and Nazimuddin Alam, was followed by a projection meeting held in front of the Arts Faculty Building.

Students wing of BKSAL, Jatiya Chhatra League also held its projection meeting for 'Bulbul-Kamal' panel on the day.

Presided over by Jahangir Sattar Tinku, the meeting was addressed among others by Nurul Fazal Bulbul, Kamal Hossain and Wahiduzzaman Chan.

Supporters of Chhatra Union, students wing of CPB, Chhatra League (H-A), students wing of Awami League, Combine of the Nine Student Organisations, Biplobi Chhatra Moncha and other participating panels also brought separate projection processions.

Meanwhile, different entry points to the university were partially restricted by the law enforcing agencies from Saturday morning as part of the precaution measures to ensure security during the ensuing DUCSU polls.

Only the students, holding valid identity cards, would be allowed to enter the campus from 24 hours before starting of vote casting and the prohibition would continue till announcement of the election results.

Casting of votes would begin at 7.30 a.m. Wednesday at 14 centres at each residential halls of the university and continue till 1.30 p.m.

All kinds of campaign would be banned 24 hours of the balloting to start.
