

Call to withdraw case against 60 RU students

Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-L) leaders at a rally Saturday urged the government and concerned authorities to take effective measures for eradicating campus violence.

The rally held on the Dhaka University campus, was addressed among others by Ishaque Ahmed, a central leader of BCL, Khizir Hayat Khan Lizu, and Pankaj Nath, President and General Secretary respectively of DU unit of BCL.

The leaders demanded immediate withdrawal of cases against 60 leaders of Rajshahi University. Terming the cases as 'false', the leaders said it was a conspiracy of the ousted Ershad regime.

The speakers also demanded arrest and trial of the killers of Badal, Organise Secretary of BCL.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Chhatra Federation President, Ahad Ahmed and General Secretary Uday Pal in a press statement Saturday demanded withdrawal of the cases filed against sixty student leaders of Rajshahi University.

The leaders called upon all progressive student organisations to raise their voice on this issue.

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
