

Problems plague M'bazar college

MAULVIBAZAR, July 3: The Maulvibazar Govt. College is facing multifarious problems. The college established in 1956 was upgraded into a government college in 1980. It has now a role strength of about 800 students. Shortage of teachers, acute accommodation problems, poor library facilities, lack of recreational facilities, lack of transport, absence of fans, shortage of furnitures, inadequate laboratory equipment are causing sufferings to the students.

There are 62 posts of the teacher in the college but now it is

running with only 31 teachers. There are also no demonstrator and physical teacher in the college. Staff quarters cannot accommodate all the teachers. As a result a good number of teachers are residing in the hostel with much inconvenience. The hostel of the college is in a deplorable condition which may collapse any time. Yet the students and teachers are compelled to reside there at a risk.

There is no librarian in the college. Library books kept in a small class room, are quite insufficient to meet the requirements of the students.

The students common rooms both for girls and boys are so small that they cannot accommodate all the students during their leisure period. The materials of indoor games are not sufficient. There is no canteen in the college.

BUS

There is no bus for the students, particularly for the girl students and as a result, they are to undergo much trouble to maintain regular attendance at the college. Inadequate scientific equipments are not sufficient to meet the requirements of the science students.

Absence of fan in some class rooms and shortage of furniture are also causing sufferings to the students.

Local Guardians earnestly desire that the sufferings of the students are removed for the interest of people education.
