

## School problems

GAIBANDHA, July 9: The education of Chapadaha Bi-lateral High School in Gaibandha-sadar thana is facing hindrances following manifold problems. The alleged carelessness of the concerned school managing committee and fund constrain are the main reasons for the draw-back of the school.

Chapadaha High School set up in 1991 not far from Gaibandha town, near Sunderganj, thana. The school is housed in a tin-shed dilapidated building with about 500 students. The students are not properly accommodated nor do they get adequate amenities due to constrain of fund. Shortage of furniture like bench, table, chair and science apparatus creates problem in the smooth education of the students.

The class rooms are very small in size. Students of many classes attend their classes standing for shortage of bench.

Out of total students 200 are girls who have a small common room to use during their leisure period. The common room is too small to accommodate increasing pressure of the students. The school committee does not bother for the extension of common room, girls students complained. Besides there is no separate toilet for the girls students.

The school building already in wornout condition has further developed cracks at different points, threatening collapse any moment. The science students face problem in their practical classes for want of adequate science apparatus, as such, they remain deprived of standard level of education.

Few days back Facilities Department erected a science building in the school but cracks have developed at places for the use of inferior and low quality construction materials.
