Decision to hold DUCSU polls hailed

Different student organisations on Thursday congratulated the University authorities for announcing the election date of DUCSU and hall unions and urged the student community to maintain peaceful atmosphere so that the election could be held smoothly.

Student organisations brought out processions and held rallies separately on the campus on Thursday hailing the decision.

Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) brought out a procession and held a rally in front of DUCSU building. It was addressed by DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokan, A.G.S. Nazimuddin Alam, Habibul Islam Habib and Ali Akkas Nadim.

The JCD leaders at the rally thanked the University authorities for announcing the date of DUCSU elections and said election is the process for practising democracy. They called upon the student community to give their verdict against terrorism.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) brought out a procession and held

rally at the foot of Aparajeyo Bangla. The rally was addressed by Quamruzzaman Ansari, University Unit Secretary of the organisation.

Speakers at the rally said, "We are always in favour of elections. The present campus situation is not in favour of free and fair elections". Armed outsiders have already taken shelter under the shade of a identified student front, he alleged. The BCL leader urged the University authorities to take necessary steps for restoration of the congenial atmosphere on the campus before the election.

Meanwhile, Jatiya Chhatra League, Chhatra League (N-S), Chhatra Union, Chhatra Federation, Chhatra Moitree and Jatiya Chhatra Dal held rallies and brought out processions on the campus and also thanked the authorities for announcing the date of DUCSU election.
