Non-govt pry school teachers call off strike

The striking teachers of non-government primary schools have called off their strike for next two months on the fifth consecutive day of their strike on Wednesday.

The teachers went on sit-in strike on Sunday and hunger strike for indefinite period on Wednesday to press home their 4-point demands.

The strike was called off when Workers Party leader Rashed Khan Menon MP offered water to teachers. Who

were on hunger strike.

Meanwhile, Jatyia Party leader Kazi Zafar Ahmed MP, Monirul Haq Chowdhury MP and JSD (Inu) General Secretary Hasanul Haq Inu on Thursday visited the striking teachers and extended their support to their 4-point demand.

Before winding up the programme President of the association Major (Retd) Asadujjaman in his speech called upon the teachers to join their respective duties from Saturday next. He also demanded of the government to accept their demand by October 31.

Otherwise they will go on greater movement including country-wide hartal from November, he warned.
