Different students organisations continued their demonstrations for a violence free campus but accused each other of unleashing terror in the educational institutions.

The demonstrating students organisations were Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), Bangladesh Chhatra League (A.A) and Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya.

The JCD rally held in front of DUCSU building, was addressed by DUCSU assistant general secretary Nazimuddin Alam, JCD DU unit General Secretary Ali Akkas Nadim and Ilias Ali.

JCD leaders resented Monday's disturbances by pro-Awami Chhatra League (BCL) activists and alleged that the Awami League and its student front were creating anarchy.

They said the activities of the suspected killers of Dr Milon had increased in recent days which caused a severe deterioration of the campus situation. They reiterated their demand of arrest and trial of the suspected killers of Dr Milon and Mahbub.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) held its rally in front of Dhaka University Madhu's Canteen which was addressed by BCL President Shahe Alam. BCL leader termed the BNP government as 'autocratic' and said it was trying to foil the progressive students' movement by using its student wing Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD). He blamed the JCD's armed hoodlums for campus violence and demanded their arrest and trial.

Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya held its rally in front of DUCSU building, which was addressed by Shafi Ahmed and Abdur Satter Khan. They said that the government was behaving irresponsibly in solving various problems of the educational institutions of the country.

They called upon the students to build up a united movement against the armed hoodlums responsible for campus violence.
