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# No girls school in 110 rural upazilas

Establishment of a separate full-fledged girl's high school in each upazila head quarter's having no girl's high school till now is needed for full fruition of the programme of administrative re-organisation and decentralisation.

The introduction of upazila system has necessitated the need for establishment of a girl's high school in the upazila headquarter's where at present no girl's high school exist. Till date 110 out of 396 rural upazila headquarter's still remain without girl's high school.

The need for setting up of a separate full-fledged girl's high school in those upazila head-quarters having no girl's high school had also been felt by the government from the very inception of the decentralisation system. Meanwhile, three years have passed since a directive in this regard was issued, but no efforts have been made.

It may be mentioned that the government has recently "nationalised" at least 30 existing girl's high schools located at upazila headquarters and fund have also been sanctioned for development of a large number of the existing girl's high schools situated in the rural areas.

But Government alone cannot be expected to shoulder the whole responsibility. So to get the benefit of "nationalisation" and financial help from the government local social and community leaders must come forward to establish a girl's high school in each of the upazila headquarters where there is yet no girl's high school.
