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7 cops, 5 students injured in Ctg clash

CHITTAGONG, Nov 3: Five students, seven police personnel including one assistant commissioner were injured in a clash between police and students in front of Nizampur College, 35 miles off here, reports BSS.

According to district police, the clash erupted when a student organisation put barricades in front of the college demanding punishment to the attackers on two of their activists who were injured at Mirersari College on the occasion of freshers' reception held yesterday.

Five of the injured students were admitted into Chittagong Medical College Hospital, where

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conditions of the two of them, Zahir and Kamrul Hasan Saheed students of Nizampur College were stated to be critical.

The assistant Commissioner of Mirersari and seven police personnel were released after first aid.

The agitating students pelted stones and blasted several hand bombs on police.

Police lathicharged, lobbed tear gas and finally fired 36 rounds of bullet to bring the situation under control.

The road communication between Dhaka and Chittagong was disrupted from this noon till filing of the report, police said.
