MPMENSINGH, Oct. 12: A week-long seminar entitled "Talents of Mymensingh" organised by the Mymensingh branch of Bangladesh Parishad, concluded here recently, reports BSS.

The seminar was inaugurated by the Information and Broadcasting Minister, Mr. Habibullah Khan on October 1. The discussion meeting was split into six sessions and the topics of the discussions included 'Chandrabati, Mansur Boyati and Mymensingh Gitikar,' Ananda Mohan Basu, 'Kedarnath Majumder' and the spirit of renaissance,' 'Jalaluddin Khan and Bauls of Mymensingh,' 'painter of Mymensingh with reference to Shilpachariya Joynal Abedin,' 'Contemporary Bengali literature with reference to Abul Kalam Shamsuddin and Principal Ibrahim Khan,' and 'Role of singers with reference to Ava Alam.'

On each topic, research papers were read followed by discussions.
