

Problems of school teachers

The non-trained teachers of newly nationalised high schools having ten or more years of experience in the same or in different schools had been graded in the scale of Tk. 470.00 per month without considering their length of service and past experience, etc., though

these teachers had been drawing same salaries and allowances in the scale of trained ones (i.e. Tk. 625/- per month) before nationalisation of these schools. The government already introduced a similar pay scale for the trained and experienced non-trained teachers for non-government secondary schools and that scale has been prevailing in the non-govt. secondary schools till today.

Now, the teachers of newly nationalised high schools having ten years of experience in the same school or twelve years in different schools urge upon the government to introduce uniform scale for the experienced non-trained teachers of both government and non-government high schools with a view to removing the existing differences in the pay scales of teachers.
