5,799 primary teachers to be recruited soon

The government would soon take steps for filling up 5,799 posts of government primary school teachers which are lying vacant for some time, Education Minister Sheikh Shahidul Islam told the Jatiya Sangsad (Parliament) recently. The minister indicated that test examinations would be organised centrally for the recruitment of teachers.

Elaborating, Sheikh Shahid said that candidates would submit application for employment to the upazila education committees, and the district education committees would scrutinise the applications. Then examinations would be organised under the four education boards of the country for the preparation of upazila-wise panel of teachers. The upazila administrations would then appoint teachers from such panels, the minister said.

The emphasis on centrally organised test examinations, it


appears, is to ensure recruitment of qualified teachers minimising the scope for nepotism or favouritism. This is going to replace the practice of making selections right at the upazila level. Before the introduction of upazila level selections recruitment of primary teachers were done, through the erstwhile subdivision level education authorities.

According to information given by the Education minister the district of Chittagong has a maximum number (312) of vacant posts of government primary school teachers. It is followed by 232 vacant posts in the district of Tangail, 177 posts in the district of Gaibandha, 164 in Rajshahi, 161 in Habiganj, 159 in Sylhet, 155 in Dhaka, 152 each in Shariatpur and Sunamganj, 151 in Bogra, 144 in Jessore and 141 in Kishorganj.

The vacant posts in other districts are as follows: Munsiganj 37, Manikganj 63, Gazipur 51, Narsingdi 60, Narayanganj 63, Rajbari 55, Faridpur 36, Madaripur 32, Jamalpur 32, Sherpur 57, Gopalganj 58, Netrakona 37.

Cox's bazar 41, Comilla 117, Khagrachhari 36, Chandpur 139, Noakhali 116, Feni 55, Bandarban 51, Brahmanbaria 61, Moulvibazar 89, Rangamati 92, Laksmpur 88.
