APSU submits memorandum to JS today

Different student organisations will submit memorandum simultaneously to the Jatiya Sangsad today (Tuesday) demanding implementation of All-Party Students Unity (APSU)'s 10-point Charter of demand, making radio and TV autonomous bodies, appeal of all black laws, filling of one lakh and thirty five thousand government vacant posts and implementation of the agreement signed by three political alliances during the anti-Ershad struggle in November last.

Except Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), all other student organisations belonging to now defunct All-Party Students Unity (APSU) will start for the Jatiya Sangsad in separate processions from the Dhaka University campus and submit memorandum to the Speaker, the Leader of the House and the Leader of the Opposition.

The organisations included were Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A), Bangladesh Chhatra League (N-S), Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Jatiya Chhatra League and Chhatra Moitrya. Earlier they brought out separate processions and held rallies.
