## No science laboratory in many secondary schools

MADARIPUR, May 15: Science education is hampering greatly due to lack of science laboratory in most of the secondary schools of the district, reports UNB.

According to official sources, only 96 out of the 125 secondary and junior secondary schools have provision for science education. But most of these schools do not have laboratory.

About 92 per cent of the laboratories built long ago have become useless. Many apparatus have already been damaged due to lack of care and maintenance.

Meanwhile, the number of science students is increasing in the schools but in the absence of adequate laboratory facilities the learners have been facing problems to continue their education.

The guardians have urged the authorities to ensure laboratory facilities in the schools

for the interest of the students.

### ONE INJURED

Another report: A man was injured in an explosion while making bomb at Shankardi village in Rajoir thana here on May 5, reports UNB.

The incident occurred while Bachu Boyati (25), son of Lokman Boyati was making bombs in the kitchen of Razzak Boyati.

Acting on a tip-off, police arrested four people including Bachnu Boyati from Shakhbar Par village at dead of night where he was undergoing treatment.
