

Plea to defer implementation of primary teachers recruitment rules

Five leaders of Bangladesh Primary Teachers' Association (Amiri) in a joint statement to the Press on Tuesday urged the government to defer the implementation of the primary school teachers recruitment rules that was announced on Monday.

They called for taking the opinions of the representatives of the association on it. They felt that the implementation of the rules would amount to dual rule on the primary education system, and that might create problems.
