University for madrasha students recommended

The establishment of "Bangladesh Arabic Islamic University" has been recommended for the affiliation of 100 Kamil and 700 Fazil madrashas of the country at the national level. The University Grants Commission committee which looked into steps to improve the standard of madrasah education also made some other recommendations, says Media syndicate.

The committee also recommended the establishment of an open university-like institution in place of the present Madrasa Education Board. The proposed university is to

conduct pre-degree madrasha examinations.

Changes in Madrasa Education Ordinance of 1978 (Ordinance No. 9) were also recommended. The committee called for awarding BA (Pass) status for Fazil examinations and MA degree status for Kamil examinations till the new university was set up.

Another committee of the University Grants Commission recommended college-level salaries for teachers of Sanskrit Colleges, Toles and Chatupadhis and regular pay-scales for them to attract brilliant teachers.

It also called for separate Sanskrit and Pali Education Board with status similar to the Madrasa Board.
