

Production oriented education system underway: Sircar

Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar on Sunday said the present democratic government had taken steps towards introducing a people and production oriented education system in the country, reports BSS.

He said steps had also been taken to educate the total population through the programme of eradicating illiteracy by the year 2000.

The Education Minister was speaking as the chief guest at the conference of the Government Secondary School Teachers of Dhaka City and Dhaka region and a seminar on "education above all" in Dhaka.

The Education Minister said the government had introduced agriculture as compulsory subject at secondary level and computerised the examination system for improving the standard of secondary education.
