

All pry schools to be made pucca by 1995

HOQMA (Comilla) April 16 : Government has a plan to construct pucca building for all primary schools by 1995 to accelerate the implementation of compulsory primary education in the country, reports UNB.

This was disclosed by Shipping Minister MK Anwar Saturday while addressing separate public meetings at Baraikandi Maisherchar and Ramprashachar villages under Homna thana.

He said government has

been pursuing a comprehensive programme for developing human resources with an aim to convert the huge unskilled population into a planned and skilled manpower.

With this objective in view the government has made the highest allocation to the sector in the national budget in the current fiscal, he said.

Besides, government is also implementing food for education, free education upto class eight for the girl student in rural areas with the aim to increase the literacy rate of country, the Minister pointed out.

The Shipping Minister said that the government was committed to eradicate illiteracy from the country by the year 2000 and is determined to remove poverty from the country.

Under the poverty alleviation programme huge quantity of money was being distributed among the people of the rural areas through different government and non-government agencies.

Anwar urged the people to avail those opportunities to help eliminate poverty from the country.

The Minister also inaugurated the newly constructed pucca building of Maisherchar government primary school by unveiling the plaque.

The building have been completed within 120 days with a total cost of about Tk 4 lakh under the third flood rehabilitation programme, said a PID handout.
