## **Workshop on problems in literacy edn**

A three-day workshop on practical problems and their solutions for the benefit of officials in charge of literacy and adult education will begin here on July 19, reports UNB.

Eduaction Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Strear will inaugurate the workshop, organised by the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (ISESCO) in cooperation with the Bangladesh Commission for UNESCO.

Officials in charge of literacy and adult education from 19 countries including Indonesia, Pakistan, Brunei Darussalam, Sierra Leone, Gambia, Guinea, the Maldives, Malaysia, Iran and host Bangladesh will participate in the workshop.

The workshop is designed to boost member states efforts in the field of literacy and enhance awareness about the importance of generalisation of basic education and promotion of adult education programmes.

It will also examine problems in literacy activities and adult education management and recommend solutions and lay down optimal strategies and methods of action in literacy programmes management.

The workshop will discuss about critical study of national experience in the fields of literacy and adult education, ISESCO's Special Islamic Programme (SIP) for literacy and basic training for all, literacy and adult education strategies, management, organisation and mobilisation and programmes, curricula and educational materials.
